

Why? Top responses:

- 1. It **taught me a lot** / I understood that... (mostly regarding to teamwork, time management, problem solving etc.)
- 2. Valuable experience prepares for the adulthood
- 3. Learnt how to work in a team especially how to manage conflicts
- 4. Social impact
- 5. New or deeper relationships
- 6. **Self-confidence** which covers becoming more open to other people, streching the comfort zone, getting to know oneself, recognizing one's strengths
- 7. Certificates

We work with teachers from 10% high-schools in Poland






We train teachers in:

- ✓ motivation
- ✓ feedback
- ✓ communication
- ✓ conflict resolving
- ✓ mentoring

Through a school year we support teachers with an online platform and community managers - teachers themselves.

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- 1. 'Freed from Theory' teachers have on average **19 years of service** there are almost no young ones!
